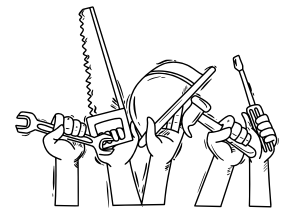


How spacious is your room?

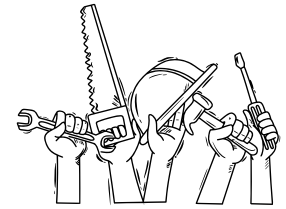


Are you working at the moment?

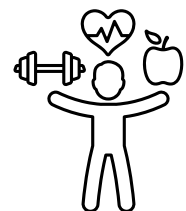


If you have a job, are you happy with your working conditions?

Do you get any social benefits? If you do, is the money enough to cover your living expenses?

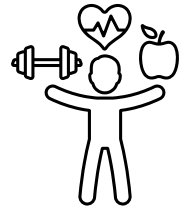
Health
